DESCRIPTION OF THE CHANGE

I. Justification, purpose and date of effectiveness of the moratorium

The request to put in a moratorium the master's program in Education in Elementary Education in its face-to-face mode, corresponds to the current four students enrolled.

II. How to notify the university community of change

Active students in the program will be identified and meetings will be cited with the Academic Director and faculty to explain the process. An individualized curriculum is attached for each student. The schedule of courses by term will be adjusted according to the need of the students of the program. The program will be removed from the official academic offer available on the official website of the Campus. All service offices will be notified of the relevant information and student referral process if necessary.

There are currently four (4) students enrolled in the Program. It is projected to finish as follow:

1 student in February 2021, 1 student in June 2021, 1 student in October 2021,

III. Explanation on the effect of change on active students in the program

Students enrolled in the program will not be affected as the Fajardo Campus has identified the particularities of each and will provide alternatives such as contract courses, hybrid or face-to-face courses so that they can complete their degree as soon as possible.
