Cooperating teachers' evaluation of clinical practice candidates' dispositions (PD11) Year 2021

The Teacher-Disposition Survey (PD11) has 20 items that measure the dispositions of trainee teachers. The scale has five levels: five is excellent, four means very good, three is good, two is deficient, and one is poor. This scale is divided into the three areas shown in table 1. This instrument has a reliability of .95, and this is excellent reliability. The Test was administered to nine clinical practice students from both semesters' year 2021. One semester had 6 clinical practice candidates s and the second semester has 3 candidates. The following table presents the 3 areas of the PD-11 Clinical practice Disposition Instrument.
