Undergraduate Level Graduate Study 2019-20
Results Report – Education Programs

Milestones data and satisfaction from IAUPR Satisfaction Survey sent in February 2020 by E Mail to Graduates from Fajardo TEP for Years 2015-16 to 2017- 2018 .

The IAUPR Institutional Office provides every 2 years data from a Graduate Satisfaction Survey they administer to all graduates. From there, they segregate data from different academic Programs and Campuses. The questionnaire was sent by email during the month of February 2020 to graduates of the academic years 2015-16 to 2017-18.

Fajardo TEP graduates filled the satisfaction Survey by E Mail and in relation to relationship with academic program /preparation and current employment the data is as follows:

- A. 3 (75%) of the graduates are working and 1(25%) is not. Also 1 (33%) graduate was already working and 1 (33 %) found a job within 1 month or less . Finally, 1 (33%) found a job between 7 months to a year.
- B. In relation to current employment and area of concentration, 3(100%) found it highly related.
- C. In relation to importance of their preparation at the FC TEP, 2 graduates (67%) found it very important and 1 graduate (33 %) found it moderately important

This information tells the TEP that our graduates highly evaluate our program and also their preparation and also, they find jobs in relation to their academic preparation. It also confirms the data the TEP receives from their Graduate satisfaction survey (EGRE S . 15) the TEP administers.

Information of the Instrument from the IAUPR Institutional Office

Purpose of the instrument

Determine the relationship between academic programs and the current employment status of graduates of the Inter-American University of Puerto Rico.

Method

The questionnaire was sent by email during the month of February 2020 to graduates of the academic years 2015-16 to 2017-18. Responses were anonymous. Cronbach's alpha reliability index for the institutional mission aspects section of the questionnaire at the systemic level is **0.91**.

Participants

A total of four graduates of the Fajardo Campus of the education programs answered the questionnaire.
