

## Completers from the Educational Leadership and Management Program ET-14 (Master's Program)

The following represents the results of three telephone interviews to Educational Leadership and Management completers. Completers finished their degree in 2022. All completers are working, 67% are currently working in a job not in line with their specialty. Of these 33% admitted that their master's degree helped them get a promotion to a level in line with their specialty. Teachers are currently working in the public school system, 33% as facilitators. The results reveal that all surveyed students found work between 0 and 6 months after graduation. The survey asked completers about the different activities that they have taken part in their current job (see table 79).
